David Gradwell. TOP GUN: - Medicine. Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October at 19.00



Group Captain (Rtd) David Gradwell served in the RAF Medical Branch for almost 29 years before moving to become Professor of Aerospace Medicine at King's College London. During his service he was deeply involved in all the aeromedical challenges of operational altitude protection for serving and future RAF personnel. This included the development of the Eurofighter Typhoon and the F-35 JSF. His RAF and academic careers included many national and international roles such as Queens Honorary Surgeon and President of both international professional aerospace medicine organisations as well as Chair of the Royal Aeronautical Society's Aerospace Medicine Group. At King's he lead the advancement of the speciality, including initiating its civilian training programme gaining GMC approval. Drawn from his service and academic knowledge and experience he will talk about aviation and space medicine, including using scenes from the recent Top Gun Maverick movie to illustrate the crucial role of aerospace medicine in delivering operational capability.
